It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licence application. The maximum fine on summary conviction is £5000.00.

NOTES:

- 1. This Notice must be displayed at the premises concerned for a period of 10 working days.**
- 2. The first working day is deemed to be the day after the day that the application was made to the Council.**
- 3. The Notice must be displayed in a prominent position where it can conveniently be read by persons from the exterior of the premises.**
- 4. In the case of a public open space or premises covering 50 square metres or larger, another notice with the same information must be displayed every 50 metres along the boundary of the premises or area.**
- 5. The Notice must be printed on white paper of A4 or larger size.**
