### **Representation in regards to Site Proposal No 30. Part ii Potential sites for New Uses**

I write in a private capacity as a resident of 144 Kenilworth Avenue, to propose that Kenilworth Green should be removed from the list of potential sites for redevelopment for an alternative use.

I have lived close by, at 114 Kenilworth Avenue, for 25 years, during which time the Green has been maintained as a public open space, by the Council and (informally) local residents. It is not a vacant site as described in the above document but a 'green space' which provides welcome relief from the intensively developed neighbourhood, with shrubs, trees, grass and seating. It serves as useful public space for walking the dog and as a meeting and relaxation point particularly for younger members of the community. After Wimbledon Park Closes it is the only public space available in the neighbourhood for these purposes. In summary it is of great benefit to the community and its immediate environment and should be retained.
