I am a resident of Kenilworth Avenue and it has come to my attention that the Council are proposing to list The Green at the end of Kenilworth Avenue as suitable for residential development. It is a public space and not, as described by the Council, a vacant site. The area has already seen increased development and indeed a residence has recently been added to the row of terraces next to the Green. This area is used extensively by dog owners, youngsters and as a general meeting place. There is also a bench where people stop and rest. I believe that this space should be retained for the continued use of local residents. There has already be vastly increased density in the area and it is important that green spaces are kept for the benefit of the public.
